Left Panel

HOUSEKEEPING CLEANING PROCEDURES FOR

PROCEDURES #1 CLEANING GUEST BATHROOMS

PRODUCT NAME: Sheraton Housekeeping Cleaner

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION: Sheraton Housekeeping Cleaner was developed to clean bathrooms quickly, and economically. When used according to procedures described below, it will completely maintain the cleanliness and sanitation of bathrooms at a quality level without the use of other products (see footnote, last page).

EQUIPMENT REQUIRED: 1 Maid's Pail, Sheraton Standard
 1 Sponge or Terry Cloth and Wiping Cloths
 1 Hand mop, Sheraton Standard
 1 Small Wet Mop with Handle, Sheraton Standard
 1 Pint Plastic Bottle and Cap
 1 Pint Plastic Bottle and Trigger Sprayer
 1 Tile and Shower Pail Brush, Sheraton Standard

MATERIAL & PREPARATION: 1. Fill one plastic bottle with full strength Sheraton Housekeeping Cleaner.
 2. Fill second pint plastic bottle with water and one capfull of Sheraton Housekeeping Cleaner, attach trigger sprayer to bottle.

PROCEDURE: 1. Remove used soap from tub/shower. Spray wall tiles, soap dishes, tub fixtures and inside of tub with solution of cleaner and water. Leave five to ten minutes.
 2. Remove soiled towels. Remove and empty all dirty ashtrays, wash in sink, wipe dry and replace in room.
 3. Spray cleaning solution on sponge or cloth and clean inside of medicine cabinet or recessed bathroom shelf, wipe dry. Replace all guest supplies to required amount.
 4. Spray toilet seat and cover, both sides, lip and exterior of bowl and wall tile around toilet with cleaning solution. Use hand swab to clean these surfaces, wipe dry. Pour 1/2 capfull of full strength cleaner into toilet bowl and leave cleaner in bowl.

5. Spray wall tile, exterior of medicine cabinet or bathroom shelf, lavatory and fixtures with solution. With damp sponge or cloth clean tile surfaces and exterior of cabinet, rinse, then wipe dry leaving no smudges. Clean lavatory with sponge or cloth inside and out, being sure to get chrome faucets and trim clean, rinse. Wipe all surfaces dry, polish fixtures with dry cloth.

6. Clean all chrome accessories, such as towel bars, Kleenex box, toilet tissue receptacle with damp sponge or cloth and polish with dry cloth. Remove finger marks on both sides of bathroom door with spray solution.

7. Lightly spray mirror with solution and wipe dry, leaving no smudges.

8. With wet sponge or cloth clean wall tile in tub area, being sure to get shower head, faucets and soap dishes clean, rinse and wipe dry. Use small brush for hard to clean corners of tile.

9. If tub area is enclosed with shower doors, lightly spray solution on inside of doors, clean with sponge or cloth and wipe dry. Do the same for exterior of shower doors. Spray shower door rail with solution, scrub with brush and remove all liquid. Wipe dry. Wipe dry all chrome trim of shower door and polish.

If tub area is enclosed with shower rod and shower curtain, clean shower rod and wipe dry. Check shower curtain, if nylon, and replace if soiled. If shower curtain is plastic, lightly spray both sides with cleaning solution, clean and wipe dry.

10. Using hand mop, clean inside of toilet bowl, being sure to get under folds. Flush toilet.

11. Replace all towels, bath mat and guest supplies as required.

12. Fill pail half full of hot water from tub. Spray bathroom floor with cleaning solution. Clean floor with small maid's mop or sponge as instructed by supervisor. Rinse and wipe dry. Replace bath rug as required.

Footnote:

Hotels that have been cleaning lavatories and tubs several years with abrasive cleansers will find it necessary to continue their use. However, Sheraton Housekeeping Cleaner can be successfully used on all other surfaces and fixtures in bathrooms and in tubs and lavatories from which the glaze has not been removed with abrasives.
