




POISON SIGNS (Symptoms)

Parathion is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly enters the body on contact with all skin surfaces and eyes. Clothing contaminated with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must receive prompt medical treatment or they may die

Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are. Headache nausea, vomiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, pin point pupils, tightness in chest, labored breathing, ner vousness, sweating, watering of eyes, droofing or frothing of mouth and nose, muscle spasms and coma

FIRST AID TREATMENT

Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition

If breathing has stopped, start artificial respiration im mediately and maintain until doctor sees victim. If swallowed and victim is awake (conscious) make him vomit quickly induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat or by giving scapy or strong salty water to drink. Repeat until vamit is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an un conscious person. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately

In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plent, of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doctor immediately

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

ANTIDOTE Administer atropine sulfate in large doses. Two to FOUR mg intravenously or intramuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals until signs of atropinization appear 2 PAM chloride is also un tidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS Parathion is a strong cholinesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression At first sign of pulmonary edme, the patient should be given supplemental oxygen and treated symptomatically. Continued abscription of the poison may occur and faial relspses have been reported after initial improvement. VERY LOSE SUPERVISION OF THE PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 18 HOURS

FOR CONTROL OF BLUE MOLD AND ANTHRACNOSE AND OF FLEA BETTLE, MIDGE LARVAE. CRANE FLY LARVAE. VEGETABLE WEEVILS. APHIDS (Plant Lice), IN TOBACCO PLANT BEDS

Begin applications when plants are about the size of a dime or when blue mold is first reported in the area. Dust regularly twice a week three applications per week are advisable during active blue mold weather. Use a good rotary hand duster on large beds. A plunger duster may be used on small beds. Apply in the early morning or in the late evening when the air is quiet preferably when plants are moist with dew. Do not fill hopper over two thirds full at any time, and make certain that all leaves on tobacco plants show a uniform film of dust. Applications of dust that are washed off by rain should be repeated as soon as possible. Usually 8 to 12 applications are required during a season.

First to Fourth 1 pounds
Fifth and Sixth 1 pounds
Seventh and Others 2 pounds
