DIRECTIONS FOR USE

North Carolina - South Carolina Peanut Belt

PEANUTS - To control leafspot, apply at the rate of 20 to 25 pounds per acre, using adequate mechanical or power-driven dusting equipment to effect uniformly thorough coverage of dust on the foliage of the peanut plants. Begin applications on Spanish Peanuts during the last week in June. Begin the applications on bunch or runner types during the first 10 days of July. Repeat at 14-day intervals until at least three, possibly five or

six applications have been made. The exact number of applications required will depend upon the frequency and amount of rainfall. Frequent rainfall or "wet weather" conditions will require the maximum number of applications. Heavy rain within 4 to 6 hours of an application will wash the dust off the peanut plants; under these conditions, the dust should be reapplied as soon as possible.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. May cause irritation of nose, throat, and skin. Avoid breathing the dust. Wear a respirator. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. In case of contact, wash skin with soap and water; for eyes, flush with plenty of water and get medical attention. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of any body of water. Apply only for the purpose and in the manner directed in this label. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift of dust from area treated. Do not use where runoff may occur as a result of heavy rain. Clean application equipment and dispose of wastes and unused chemical in a pit on non-crop land well away from water supplies.

DESTROY EMPTY CONTAINERS. Do not reuse this container for any purpose. Bury empty container in a pit on non-cropland well away from water supplies.
