DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FCX CHLORDANE 4 "L" is an emulsifiable concentrate and should be mixed with water. Some agitation is needed while spraying. If allowed to stand for any length of time, re-agitate thoroughly before use.

LAWNS AND ORNAMENTAL TURF

ANTS; ARMYWORMS; CHIGGERS; EARWIGS; SOD WEBWORMS. Use 3 tablespoonfuls mixed in 3 gallons of water to spray grass on each 1000 square feet of lawn area. (Equivalent to approximately 2 quarts in sufficient water to spray 1 acre.) Apply when insects appear and repeat applications as necessary.

WHITE GRUBS; JAPANESE BEETLE LARVAE; GREEN JUNE BEETLE LARVAE. Use 6 tablespoonfuls mixed in 3 gallons of water to spray grass on each 1000 square feet of lawn area. (Equivalent to approximately 4 quarts in sufficient water to spray 1 acre.) Apply in early spring and/or late fall. Repeat application annually as necessary.

FIRE ANTS. Mix 4 tablespoonfuls in 3 gallons of water. Break open hard surface of mound and pour 3 cupfuls of mixture in each mound. Spray

TERMITES

Remove all wood and other cellulose material in contact with the soil. Prepare a water emulsion containing 1 percent Chlordane by mixing 1 pint of this concentrate in 6-1/4 gallons of water (1 gallon in 50 gallons) and apply as follows:

(a) For application under attached porches, platforms, and utility entrances, use 1 gallon of water mixture per 1000 square feet of soil surface.

(b) Along outside of foundation walls, dig a trench 8 to 10 inches wide and up to 30 inches deep, but not below the footing; pour a portion of the water-mixture evenly into the trench throughout its length, replace part of the soil and apply additional water-mixture. Repeat process until trench is filled. If foundation wall is shallow (15 inches or less), apply no less than 2 gallons of water-mixture per 5 linear feet; if foundations are deep (more than 15 inches), apply 4 gallons per linear feet.

(c) For unexposed soil under terraces, patios, sidewalks, or driveways, use 2 gallons of water-mixture per 5 linear feet. Apply close to foundation wall by drilling or apply through expansion joints.

(d) For soil treatment prior to pouring concrete slabs, use 1 gallon of the water-mixture per 10 square feet. Where slabs join inside walls or service entrances, use 2 gallons per linear foot.

Inspect treated areas semi-annually and repeat if necessary.
