DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CUCUMBERS AND MELONS--To control cucumber beetles and pickleworm, apply the dust uniformly to upper and lower surfaces of foilage and into blossoms (30 to 40 pounds of dust per acre.) Begin applications when insects first appear, which is usually when the plants are in the 4 to 6 leaf stage, and repeat if necessary at 5 to 10 day intervals, depending upon severity of insect infestation and weather conditions favorable to insect development. DO NOT APPLY TO CUCUMBERS WITHIN 1 DAY OF HARVEST.

SQUASH AND PUMPKIN-- To control aphids on foilage, pickleworm, and squash vine borer, apply the dust uniformly to upper and lower surfaces of foilage, to stems and vines at base of plants, and into blossoms (30 to 40 pounds of dust per acre). Begin applications when the plants are small (4 to 6 leaf stage) and repeat if necessary at 7 day intervals depending upon insect infestation and weather conditions favorable to insect development.
