DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

FOX Cattle Grub & Louse Powder is a ready to use insecticide. It should be applied at the rate of 4 to 6 ounces per animal, depending on size, for the control of cattle grubs and lice.

Begin treatments when grub openings first appear or lice are present. For grubs, dust along the animal's back, and brush vigorously with a stiff brush to make sure material gets through the hair to the skin and well into the grub openings. For lice, dust thoroughly those areas inhabited, again making sure material gets through the hair to the skin.

Repeat applications every two weeks, or as often as necessary for effective control during winter months.

DO NOT USE ON SWINE: Swine are very susceptible to Rotenone and could be harmed by this product.
