POISONING SYMPTOMS: Headache; Nausea; Cramps; Blurred Vision; Ataxia;

Contact a physician immediately if a person handling or working with this product develops any of these poisoning symptoms.

ANTIDOTE: Atropine is the specific antidote for parathione. Obtain a supply of Atropine 1/100 grain tablets from your physician and keep on hand.

First Aid Treatment

If Parathion is swallowed, give a warm salt water solution, or other emetic to induce vomiting. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Keep person lying in a prone position. Call a physician!

If ParatKion is installed, receive a new fire-contaminated steel beam and a fire test.

If Parathion comes in contact with skin, immediately wash skin thoroughly with water. Before reuse, wash contaminated clothing thoroughly with cold water.

If Parathion gets into eyes, immediately flush thoroughly with plain water. Continue flushing operation for at least 15 minutes.

Information for Physician: To treat for parathormone poisoning, give calcium gluconate by injection, in prescribed doses, immediately after every meal, and at first signs of

needed, to achieve and maintain full atropinization. Artificial respiration and administration of oxygen may be necessary. Continue to observe patient for at least 48 hours, or until full recovery is evident. Never give morphine.

- DANGER -

Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Particles are rapidly absorbed through the skin. Do not get into eye, on skin or clothing.

Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing, and goggles. Wear respirator of a type recommended by U. S. Department of Agriculture for protection against parathion. Pilots of aircraft applying parathion should wear full-face respirator type mask. Apply only when there is no danger of material drifting onto unprotected areas. Keep all unprotected humans and animals out of operating area or vicinity where there may be danger of drift.

Do not allow to contaminate feed or foodstuffs. Wash thoroughly hands, face, hair, and other unprotected areas with soap and water after using parathion, and before eating, drinking or smoking. Wash thoroughly all contaminated clothing in cold and hot water before re-using.

This material will kill fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, ponds and streams. Do not apply in any area not specified on this label.

This product is toxic to bees. Any use of the product when bees are visiting the crop will seriously reduce bee populations. Bees are important pollinators and are essential to the production of many crops. Before using this product during such periods consult your state Agricultural Extension Service.

Clean equipment thoroughly and dispose of waste by burying in non-crystallizing from water supplies. Dispose of empty container in same manner, or by burning. If empty bag is burned, avoid breathing the smoke.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

FCX 10% Sevin* - 1% Parathion Dust is a ready to use product. Application should be made when wind is calm to avoid drift into unprotected areas.

Tobacco: For the control of Hornworms, Fleabeetles, Aphids, suckfly and beetles, apply 15 to 25 pounds per acre with either ground or aircraft equipment. Thorough coverage is essential. Use lesser rates for smaller plants and greater rates for large plants and heavy infestation. Make application as required based on infestation and weather conditions.

IF WORKERS MUST HANDLE TOBACCO WITHIN 5 DAYS OF APPLICATION, WEAR PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND GLOVES.

DO NOT PRUNE WITHIN 5 DAYS, OR CUT WITHIN 15 DAYS, OF APPLICATION.
SOME PHYTOXICITY MAY OCCUR ON PLANTS FOLLOWING THE PARATHION DUST.
DO NOT PLANT SENSITIVE CROPS FOR A PERIOD OF SEVERAL DAYS DURATION FOLLOWING APPLICATION OR HEAVY RAINFALLS.
