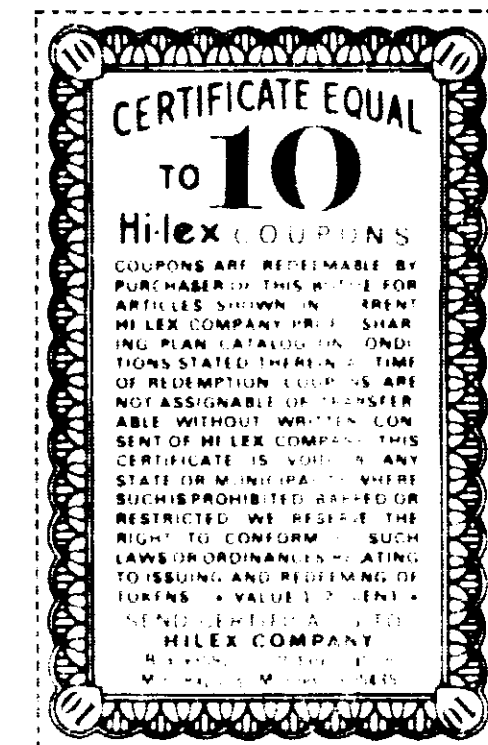

This bleach will stain paper. Use only on appropriate surfaces. KEEP UPRIGHT IN COOL PLACE, TIGHTLY CAPPED.

PURPOSE	AMOUNT	DIRECTIONS
<b>LAUNDERING.</b> To bleach and sanitize white and color-fast cotton, linen, nylon, dacron, orlon, polyester, dynel and rayon in washing machine.	1 cup Hi-lex per load for conventional washing machine; ½ cup for front load automatic.	Add to pre-soak, wash water or first rinse. If clothes are in machine, dilute Hi-lex in 1 quart water before adding.
<b>TO WHITEN NYLON AND OTHER SYNTHETICS</b> that have turned yellow or grey.	1 tablespoon Hi-lex per gallon water.	Soak clean fabric in solution for 15 to 20 minutes. Rinse well. Repeat if necessary.
<b>TO REMOVE STAINS.</b> Berry, wine, coffee, tea, ink, grass, dye, medicine stains, scorch and mildew.	Make solutions of 2 tablespoons Hi-lex to each quart water.	Immerse fabric for 5 to 10 minutes. Rinse well in clear water. Repeat if necessary.
<b>TO CLEAN KITCHEN AND BATHROOM.</b> Refrigerator, tile, bathtub, etc.	2 tablespoons Hi-lex to 1 quart water.	Wash, rinse and dry.
<b>SICK ROOM EQUIPMENT.</b> To disinfect, deodorize and remove stains.	3 tablespoons Hi-lex per each quart of water.	For rubber sheets, bedpans, dishes, utensils, etc., immerse or keep article wet in solution for 5 minutes. Rinse. <i>Rinse food contact surfaces with potable water before reuse.</i>
<b>DEODORIZING AND SANITIZING.</b> Baby clothes, diapers, dish cloths, handkerchiefs, etc.	1 tablespoon Hi-lex to 1 gallon water.	First wash, then soak in solution for 5 minutes. Rinse well.
<b>TO DEODORIZE DRAINPIPES.</b>	1 cup Hi-lex.	Flush with hot water, then add Hi-lex.
<b>GARBAGE CANS.</b>	3 tablespoons Hi-lex to each quart water.	Wash can in hot suds, rinse, then wash with solution. Keep wet for 5 to 10 minutes, rinse.
<b>TOILET BOWLS.</b>	½ cup Hi-lex	Cleanse and flush, then add ½ cup solution over inside surface and let stand 10 minutes.
<b>WADING POOLS.</b>	½ cup Hi-lex to 100 gal. water.	Mix ½ cup Hi-lex in 2 gallons water and spread uniformly over surface. Between fillings add ½ cup Hi-lex per 100 gal. water each day. Small pools should be emptied daily.
<b>DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING EATING AND DRINKING UTENSILS</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.</li> <li>Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.</li> <li>Rinse with clean water.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sanitize in solution of 1 oz. to 2 gallons of water (200 p.p.m.) Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.</li> <li>Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.</li> </ol>
<b>TODAY'S PERMANENT PRESS FABRICS ARE BLEACHABLE, and need Hi-lex to get out stains and help prevent dirt build-up. Wash with regular laundry as directed below:</b>		
Top-loading automatics — 1 cup per load Wringer-type washers — 1 cup per load Front-loading automatics — ½ cup per load	Use Hi-lex with any good laundry soap or detergent. If your washer has an automatic bleach dispenser, follow washer directions. If not, add Hi-lex whichever way is more convenient:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To wash water before laundry is put in, or...</li> <li>If laundry is put in before wash water, then dilute Hi-lex in quart of water and add after machine has started agitating and fabrics are thoroughly wet.</li> </ol>

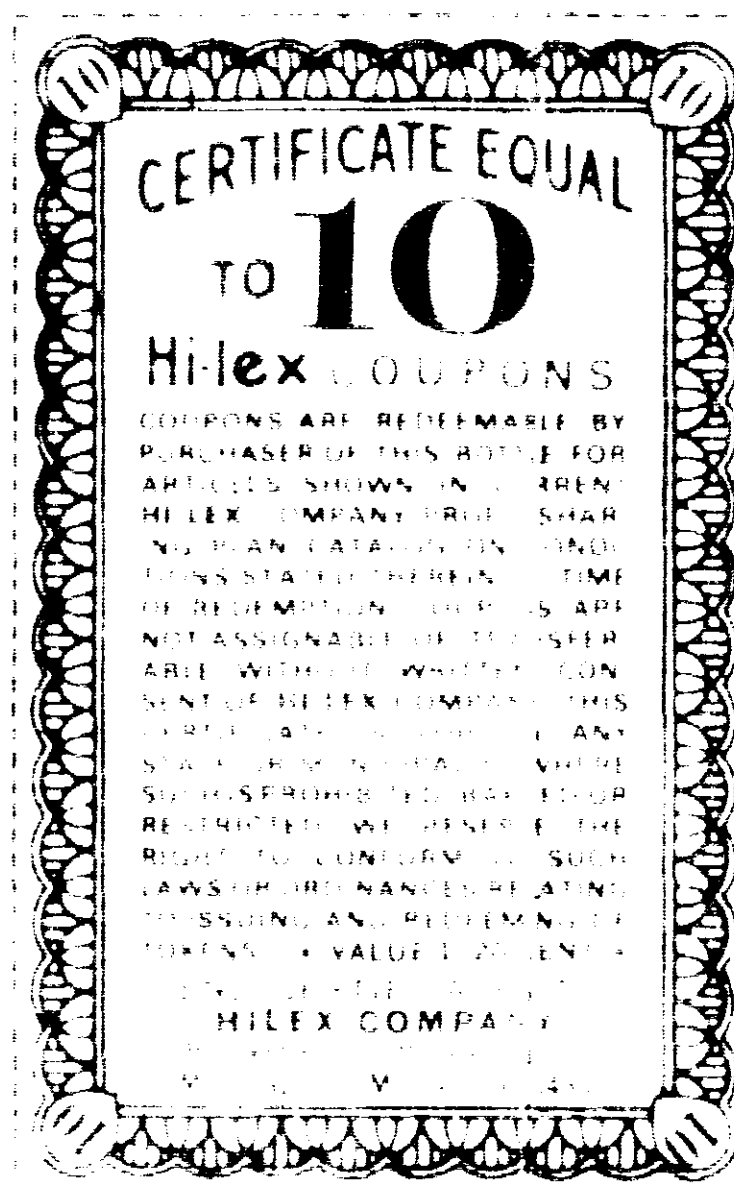
