LAUNDERING. To bleach and sanitize white and color-fast cotton, linen, nylon, dacron, orlon and rayon in washing machine.

TO WHITEN NYLON AND OTHER SYNTHETICS that have turned yellow or grey.

TO REMOVE STAINS. Fruit, berry, wine, coffee, tea. ink, grass, dye, medicine stains, scorch and mildew

1 cup bleach per load for conventional washing machine; ½ cup for front load automatic.

1 tablespoon bleach per gallon water.

Make solutions of 2 tablespoons bleach to each quart water.

2 tablespoons bleach to 1 quart

3 tablespoons bleach per each quart of water.

1 tablespoon bleach to 1 gallon water.

1 cup bleach.

3 tablespoons bleach to each quart water.

1/2 cup bleach.

1 quart bleach for each 12,000 gallons water.

Add to pre-soak, wash water or first rinse. If clothes are in machine, dilute bleach in 1 quart water before adding.

Soak clean fabric in solution for 15 to 20 minutes. Rinse well Repeat if necessary.

immerse fabric for 5 to 10 minutes. Rinse well in clear water. Repeat if necessary.

Wash, rinse and dry.

For rubber sheets, bedpans, dishes, utensils, etc., immerse or keep article wet in solution for 5 minutes, Rinse.

First wash, then soak in solution for 5 minutes. Rinse well.

Flush with hot water, then add bleach.

Wash can in hot suds, rinse, then wash with solution. Keep wet for 5 to 10 minutes, rinse.

Cleanse and flush, then add 1/2 cup solution over inside surface and let stand 10 minutes. Safe with septic tanks.

Dilute bleach with 5 gallons water and distribute evenly over surface of pool. Add bleach periodically to maintain 0.6 ppm available chlorine, using test kit acceptable to Public Health authorities.

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING EATING AND DRINKING UTENSILS

- 1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
- 2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.
- 3. Rinse with clean water.
- 4. Sanitize in solution of 1 oz. to 2 gallons of water (200 p.p.m.) Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
- 5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.


