DIRECTIONS

LAUNDERING. To bleach and sanitize white and color-fast cotton, linen, nylon, dacron, orlon and rayon in washing machine.

1 cup bleach per load for conventional washing machine; 1/2 cup for front load automatic.

Add to pre-soak, wash water or first rinse. If clothes are in machine, dilute bleach in 1 quart water before adding.

TO WHITEN NYLON AND OTHER SYNTHETICS that have turned yellow or grey.

1 tablespoon bleach per gallon water.

Soak clean fabric in solution for 15 to 20 minutes. Rinse well. Repeat if necessary.

TO REMOVE STAINS. Fruit, berry, wine, coffee, tea, ink, grass, dye, medicine stains, scorch and mildew.

Make solutions of 2 tablespoons bleach to each quart water.

Immerse fabric for 5 to 10 minutes. Rinse well in clear water. Repeat if necessary.

TO CLEAN KITCHEN AND BATHROOM. Refrigerator, tile, bathtub, etc.

2 tablespoons bleach to 1 quart water.

Wash, rinse and dry.

SICK ROOM EQUIPMENT. To disinfect, deodorize and remove stains.

3 tablespoons bleach per each quart of water.

For rubber sheets, bedpans, dishes, utensils, etc., immerse or keep article wet in solution for 5 minutes. Rinse.

DEODORIZING AND SANITIZING. Baby clothes, diapers, dish cloths, handkerchiefs, etc.

1 tablespoon bleach to 1 gallon water.

First wash, then soak in solution for 5 minutes. Rinse well.

TO DEODORIZE DRAINPIPES.

1 cup bleach.

Flush with hot water, then add bleach.

GARBAGE CANS.

3 tablespoons bleach to each quart water.

Wash can in hot suds, rinse, then wash with solution. Keep wet for 5 to 10 minutes, rinse.

TOILET BOWLS.

1/2 cup bleach.

Cleanse and flush, then add 1/2 cup solution over inside surface and let stand 10 minutes. Safe with septic tanks.

TO HELP KEEP SWIMMING POOLS SAFE.

1 quart bleach for each 12,000 gallons water.

Dilute bleach with 5 gallons water and distribute evenly over surface of pool. Add bleach periodically to maintain 0.6 ppm available chlorine, using test kit acceptable to Public Health authorities.

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING EATING AND DRINKING UTENSILS

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in solution of 1 oz. to 2 gallons of water (200 p.p.m.) Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.

—Bleach is concentrated and must be diluted. If undiluted, may irritate eyes, skin or lungs. **IF SWALLOWED—**Feed milk. **CALL PHYSICIAN.** **IF EXTERNAL—**Flood with Water.
