

DIRECTIONS

- **LAUNDRY USE**... To Bleach... follow directions recommended by machine manufacturer. For scorch, fruit, tea, coffee, mildew, medicine, grass stains, soak in solution of $\frac{1}{2}$ cup Super Valu Bleach to 1 quart water. Rinse well.
- **KITCHEN AND BATHROOM USE**... Use $\frac{1}{4}$ cup Super Valu Bleach to 1 quart of water to cleanse, deodorize and disinfect surfaces. Rinse with clear water. Clean and Flush Toilet — Use $\frac{1}{2}$ cup Super Valu Bleach undiluted, swab all surfaces and let stand overnight.
- **FLOORS**... To remove old wax and hard-to-remove marks and stains, use $\frac{1}{2}$ cup Super Valu Bleach to each gallon of warm suds. Rinse with clear water. Dry mop.
- **WADING POOLS**... Add 1 oz. Super Valu Bleach per 100 gallons fresh water. Mix bleach in 2 or 3 gallons of water and spread over edge of water area. Between fillings, add 1 oz. bleach per 100 gallons each day. Small pools should be emptied daily.

CAUTION Do not use on silk, wool, spun rayon, leather or dyed colors. Not for personal use. Do not use with household cleaners, toilet bowl cleaners, or bowl cleaners. Bleach is concentrated and must be diluted. Do not use on children's toys. Rinse immediately if swallowed. Harmful if swallowed. If taken internally, call a physician.

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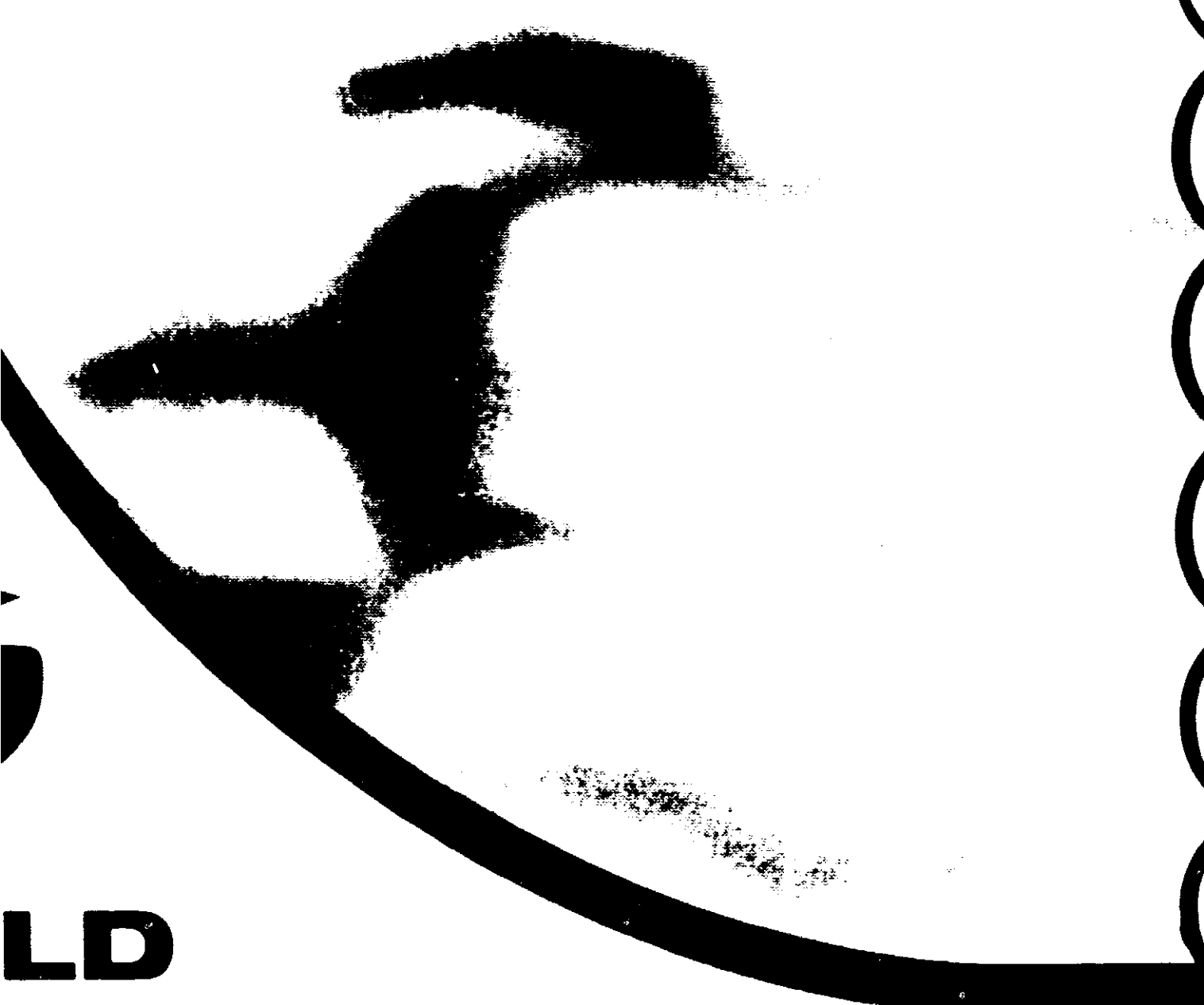

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING EATING AND DRINKING UTENSILS

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in solution of 1 oz. to 2 gallons of water (200 p.p.m.) Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.
