

- Linen
- Rayon
- Acrylic (Orlon)
- Acetate
- Nylon
- Polyester (Dacron)
- Madacrylic (Dynel)
- Trifacetate (Arnel)

Do not use on silk, wool, mohair, leather, spandex or any non-fast colors.

DIRECTIONS for using Bleach

In top-loading automatics and wringer washers, use 1 cup Superamerica Bleach per load; for front-loading washers, 1/2 cup per load. Add Superamerica Bleach to wash water before adding laundry, if possible. Otherwise, dilute in quart of water and add after machine is started and fabrics are saturated with water. Rinse. With Automatic Bleach Dispensers, follow washer directions.

(fruit, vegetable, grass, coffee, tea, chocolate, wine, many inks and medicines, plus scorch and mildew): Mix 1/2 cup Superamerica Bleach per gallon of hot water. Before laundering, soak entire stained item in this solution for 5 minutes. Rinse well. Repeat if necessary. Use cool water for: Stains set by hot water such as egg, milk or blood; colored or delicate fabrics.

from Bathtubs, Showers, Sinks, Drainboards, Refrigerators, Stoves, Dishes, Teapots, Glassware, Enamelware, Windows, Woodwork, Tile, Plastic, Marble, Porcelain Wash, then wipe with cloth or vinyl sponge, wet with solution of 3 tbsp. Superamerica Bleach to each quart of warm water. Rinse, dry. (If stubborn stains persist, keep wet 5 minutes with Superamerica Bleach solution. Repeat if necessary.) Do not use on silver, aluminum, steel, chipped enamelware.

● CAUTION: Superamerica Bleach is concentrated and must be diluted.

- Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
- Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.
- Rinse with clean water.
- Sanitize in solution of 1 oz. to 2 gallons of water (200 P.P.M.)
- Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
- Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.
