Remove protective cap. Direct nozzle opening away from you and toward fabric surface. Press down valve to release spray.

Woolen articles should be clean before treatment. Hold container about 18 inches from fabric and move spray across at about 1 foot per second. To avoid waste, space applications about 6 inches apart. Avoid saturating; properly sprayed articles should be just moist to the touch. For best results, spray article on both sides where possible. Pay special attention to seams, cuffs, folds and tufts. Some dyes are not colorfast, under any conditions, so test REEFER-GALLER MOTH PROOFER on an inconspicuous portion of the article being treated. Do the same with pile fabrics since partial moistening may affect the nap. An average suit takes about 2 minutes spraying time, a medium weight branket about 4 minutes. For additional protection, spray insides of closets and storage containers. Direct spray toward cracks and baseboards where insects may hide and breed. REEFER-GALLER MOTH PROOFER will not injure furs; however, furs should be moth-proofed by experts.
