# PRESSURIZED MOTHINE CEDARIZED SPRAY

CAUTION: COMBUSTIBLE MIXTURE

USDA Reg. No. 1864-14

**TO USE:** Remove protective cap. Hold container upright with spray opening directed away from you and toward area to be sprayed. Push button down with finger tip. Release button to stop spray.

**CAUTION:** Since some persons may be hypersensitive to various substances, never spray directly on humans. Avoid inhalation. Keep this and other similar household products out of the reach of children. Avoid contaminating food or utensils. Avoid wetting fingers at nozzle as contact with propellant may cause frostbite. In case of contact wash off with soap and water. Never store in temperature above 120°F. or in direct sunlight. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not spray directly on plastics, asphalt, vegetation or material affected by petroleum distillates. Do not spray near open flame or smoke while spraying. Remove pets, birds, cages and fishbowls from spraying area.

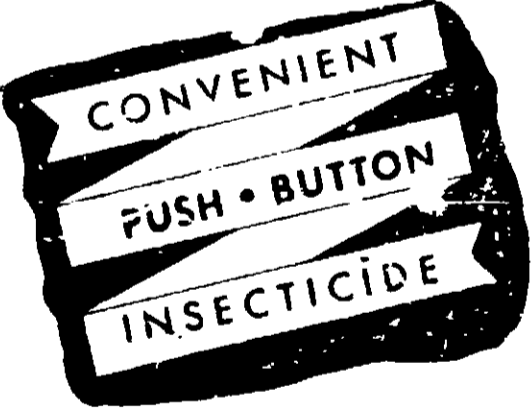

### DIRECTIONS

**MOTHS, CARPET BEETLES, THEIR EGGS and LARVAE:** CLOTHING, DRAPERIES, BLANKETS, ETC., should be well brushed, cleaned and if possible exposed to sunlight. Spray thoroughly on both sides and into seams and folds. Spray monthly unless stored in tight containers. Clean and spray closets, especially cracks — then spray garments thoroughly. Hang MOTHINE in every storage closet for constant protection (see label).

**CARPETS AND RUGS** should be thoroughly swept and cleaned on both sides. Use a vacuum cleaner. Expose carpets to sunlight then spray extra well on both sides and while still damp, they should be rolled up in newspaper and tied. Carpets in use should be thoroughly sprayed twice a month.

**ARTICLES TO BE PACKED AWAY:** Thoroughly brush and clean. Then spray well on both sides and into seams and folds. Pack in airtight trunks or chests which have been cleaned and MOTHINE-sprayed for added protection sprinkle MOTHINE NUGGET CRYSTALS among the folds.

**IMPORTANT:** Be sure to remove grease spots. Hold container two feet from article being sprayed. Some dyes are not colorfast under any conditions. Test MOTHINE on an inconspicuous portion. Do the same with the fabrics, since partial moistening may affect the nap.

**FLYING MOTHS, FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, HORNETS AND WASPS:** For best results, close all doors and windows before spraying. Stand in center of room and spray above you in all directions, then leave room and close door. After fifteen minutes, doors and windows should be opened and the treated area ventilated before occupancy.

**ANTS, ROACHES, SILVERFISH AND OTHER CRAWLING INSECTS:** Spray directly on insects when possible and into cracks, crevices, around sinks, drains and pipes, stoves, baseboards and all other places where insects may hide. Spray ant trails and around doors and window sills.

**BED BUGS:** Spray insects directly. Thorough and repeated treatment of beds, mattresses, baseboards, floor and wall cracks should be made. Spray from two feet away.

**OUT OF DOORS:** Spray barbecue pits and patio areas wherever insects are present. Do not spray while fire is lit. Spray garbage cans inside and out.

In all cases repeat treatment as often as necessary
