1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
  - a. Revise the "Sanitization" heading to read "Sanitization (Non-Food Contact Surfaces)."
  - b. Delete the following statement "Those surfaces which will contact food must be rinsed with water of drinking quality before use."
  - c. Include the "Directions For Use" heading.
  - d. Remove the misuse statement "It is a violation of Federal law . . . ." It must appear directly below the "Directions For Use."
  - e. Revise the "First Air" statement to read:

f. Add the Note to Physician statement to read:

g. Add a 5-minute contact time for sanitization.


h. Add a 10-minute contact time for disinfection.

## FOR CLEANING

**LIGHTLY SOILED AREAS**—Surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 ounce of GERMATROL 1522 per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

## GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in schools, restaurants, rest rooms and other public areas, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 1 ounce of GERMATROL 1522 per gallon of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned with 2-3 ounces of GERMATROL 1522 per gallon of water and then disinfected. Those surfaces which may later come in contact with food must be rinsed with clear water of drinking quality.

To disinfect locker rooms, shower stalls, wall-mounted pools and other areas where fungicidal action is required, mop area with a solution containing 1/2 ounce in 1 gallon of water. This solution will destroy *Trichophyton interdigitale*, a causative agent of athlete's foot. It is a violation of the Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

## HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 2 ounces of GERMATROL 1522 per gallon of water. Those surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, fecal material or exudates should be thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 2 ounces per gallon of water and then rinsed with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces per gallon of water before disinfection.

## SANITIZATION

To sanitize walls and floors, first clean thoroughly with a solution containing 1/2 ounce of GERMATROL 1522 per gallon of water. If surface is heavily soiled, use GERMATROL 1522 at a rate of 2-3 ounces per gallon to insure thorough cleaning. Sanitize cleaned surface with a rinse solution containing 1/2 ounce of GERMATROL 1522 per gallon of water. Surfaces which will contact food must be rinsed with clear water of drinking quality before use.

## DEODORIZATION

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning, mop or brush surface with a solution containing 2 ounces of GERMATROL 1522 per gallon of water. GERMATROL 1522 is an antibacterial cleaner designed for use in hospital and institutional cleaning. When used as directed, GERMATROL 1522 will disinfect hard surfaces such as floors, walls, counter tops and furniture. It is also used to deodorize bathroom areas, garbage storage areas, kennel areas and other areas where strong odors may develop. This product may be used as a general purpose antimicrobial agent as well as against bacteria and pathogenic fungi in hospitals, restaurants, hotels, nursing homes, public processing plants and in other places where deodorizing and antimicrobial action is desired. See left panel for use directions.

## FIRST AID

In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes, then get medical attention promptly. In case of skin contact, flush skin with water for at least 15 minutes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, do not vomit, drink large quantities of fluids and get medical attention immediately.
