Surface Treatment

Warlasco Industrial Spray not only gives rapid initial kill of the most stubborn species of insects but remains effective in cracks and crevices where insects hide. Apply in a good machine adjustment to deliver a fine droplet spray using approximately 1 gallon of material to each 100 square feet of surface.

In processing plants, kitchens and other food handling and storage areas spray walls, floors and other surfaces thoroughly with particular attention to cracks, crevices and other protected locations. Spray surfaces should be cleaned before spraying. Do not spray in food handling and processing areas and only use in accordance with instructions printed on label and on equipment.

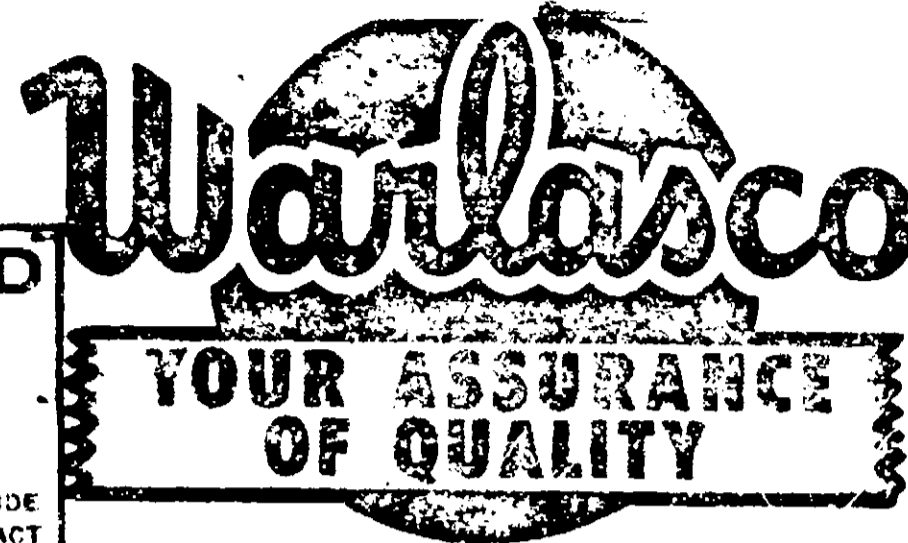
For insect control in homes, institutions and schools, box tops and shipboard, use Warlasco Industrial Spray in accordance with instructions printed on label and on equipment.

NET CONTENTS GALLONS

Space Spray: For rapid control use Warlasco Industrial Spray in a good machine adjustment to deliver a fine mist. Whenever possible keep doors and windows closed for ten minutes after application. Against flying insects direct the spray toward the upper portions of the enclosure filling the room with a mist and using 1/2 ounce of material to each 1,000 cubic feet of space. In the control of active stages of running and crawling pests direct the mist toward and into all places commonly inhabited by these insects, or use as space treatments as an aid in the control of crawling insects, at the rate of 2 ounces per 1,000 cubic feet of space.

Vapor Spray

Pyrethrum-Type Mist Spray is a potent spray that permits its use as a fog or vapor treatment in special electric, steam or compressed air equipment. Use in accordance with manufacturers' directions for the individual type of applicator selected. Dosages vary with different generators, but many such applicators are designed to give most effective results when the material is used at 1 pint to each 8,000-15,000 cubic feet of space. In all cases, dosage should be sufficient to fill thoroughly the enclosure with fog or vapor.

SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks

In controlling fleas and brown dog ticks in houses, direct the application toward the lower wall portions, baseboards, rugs, carpets and floors of infested areas. Animal quarters, kennels and bedding should also be sprayed.

Bedbugs

To control bedbugs effectively, apply liberally to top, ends, sides and bottom of mattresses, spraying thoroughly all ruffs, seams and folds. Spray springs and frame directing the liquid into all cracks and lock joints. Treat walls, baseboards, moldings, floors, closets and bedroom furniture, with particular attention to protected bedding tubing and breeding places.

Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles

For most effective control of clothes moths and carpet beetles, remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly and, if possible, air several hours in direct sunlight. Apply spray liberally to all articles, to closets, drawers and storage, directing the liquid into cracks, joints, and crevices. After using, infested articles may be treated by holding the spray nozzle at least a foot away from the fabric and spraying the liquid to the surface and the possibility of staining. Do not both sides of mats, carpets and padding, and all exposed and accessible surfaces of closets, drawers, and other storage areas should be sprayed. Do not store in unsealed containers.

Food Storage Insects

As with other insects, weevils, moths, grain beetles, meal worms, spider beetles, and mites, sprays, granules and chese-mites frequently become a problem. To avoid sources of trouble, remove worms, flour, grain and cereals should be cleaned before treatment. Spray thoroughly...
