Polybutenes	48.5%
Hydrogenated Castor Oil.....	1.5%
Inert Ingredients	50%

DIRECTIONS: Shake well before using. Apply to clean, dry surfaces. Remove protective cap. Invert can to operate; press side of spray tip. Hold near to surface and move rather rapidly to obtain a continuous line of BIRD TANGLEFOOT. Foamy material will settle somewhat after application. Treat roosting places such as window sills, ridge lines of roofs, gutter edges, tops of signs, ornamental copings, cornices, and ledges. On ledges, apply a line about 1/2 inch from the outer edge with another line 2-3 inches back. On extra wide ledges, apply several such lines, or, apply a line front and back with "S" or "Z" lines between. On exceptionally porous, or absorbent surfaces, although not essential, an undercoating such as paint may be preferred. Where prompt removal is anticipated, applications may be made over waterproof masking tape or other cover material. Solvents may be useful to remove BIRD TANGLEFOOT.

On exceptionally porous or absorbent surfaces, although not essential, an undercoating with a paint may be preferred. When prompt removal is anticipated, no action may be made over a surface of masonry, tile, or other cover material. Solvent may be used to remove BIRD TANGLEFOOT.
