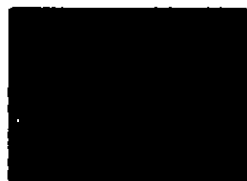

Directions

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply to clean, dry surfaces. Remove dirt, droppings, and other foreign matter to ensure adhesion. On porous or absorbent surfaces, apply an undercoating such as paint or sealant. For prompt removal, apply over waterproof roofing tape or similar material. Cut cartridge apart on angle at line marked "A." On ledges, apply a line with a width of 1/2 - 1/8 inch (10-12 mm). Do not make under lines. Apply a line 1 inch (2.5 cm) from the outer edge of ledge. On wide ledges, make several lines 2 - 3 inches apart (5 - 8 cm), or 2 lines joined by "S" shaped lines. Leave gaps for water drainage. **WET TOX:** approximately 10 level feet (3 m).

Removal

TANGLEFOOT BIRD REPELLENT can be removed with mineral spirits or clearing solvents.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in warm location prior to use. Keep in original container in dry place, away from children and pets.
Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap container and discard in trash.
