DIRECTIONS

TO OPERATE: Remove protective cap. Hold
container upright. Aim away from you. Push
button to release spray.

For long range spraying, direct jet stream
at target.

For short range residual spraying, hold
container about 14 to 18 inches from
surface being treated. Apply around doorways,
window sills, and places where insects may
alight, crawl, or congregate.

TO KILL WASPS, BEES, HORNETS, ANTS AND
SPIDERS: aim directly at the nest or in-
fested area and apply until wet. Best
results are obtained when applications are
made in early morning or evening when the
pests are more at rest or congregating
around nests.

Insects hit directly will drop in 2 to 3
seconds. Insects crawling over treated
surfaces will die soon after.

Spray wasps and hornets only when they are
at rest, or when direct hits are assured.
Do not attempt to spray flying insects.
