The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with amended registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, subject to the following comments, and a stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

At the next printing of the subject labeling:

1. Our calculations (based upon the submitted Confidential) indicate that the Petroleum distillate declaration should be "96.600%" with the "INERT INGREDIENTS" adjusted to "2.587%".
2. The terms "ACTIVE INGREDIENTS" and "INERT INGREDIENTS" must be of the same type size, prominence, and aligned to the same margin on the label. (The type size of "ACTIVE INGREDIENTS" should be reduced and moved slightly to the left. Alternatively, the type size of "INERT INGREDIENTS" could be increased.)
3. Insert the following to immediately precede "Harmful if swallowed..." (immediately following "HAZARDS TO HUMANS..."): "CAUTION".
4. Revise "wash thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking."

(Underline indicates text to be added and should not be reproduced on the label.)

Comments 3 and 4 were overlooked in our last review; we regret any inconvenience that this may cause you.
