Your Application Dated December 17, 1987

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted.

1. Delete the portion of your label that reads:

CAUTION

MAY BE HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. If swallowed, give 3 tablespoons of vinegar or lemon juice in glass of water or 1 glass of orange juice. Give as much additional fluid as possible but do not give milk. Irritating to eyes. For eyes: Flush with cool water for at least 15 minutes. May cause skin irritation. In case of contact with skin, wash with cool water and soap. Get medical attention.

Replace that with the following:

PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID)

If Swallowed: Drink promptly a large quantity of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention.

If In Eyes: Wash with plenty of soap and water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

If On Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.



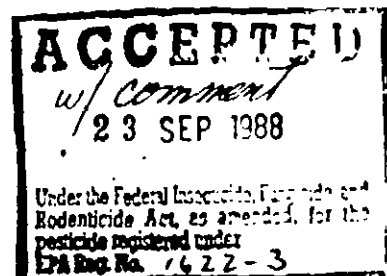
