#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

BORASCU is applied only in dry form directly to the soil. Subsequent rainfall or artificial watering is necessary to dissolve the material and render it available for absorption by plant roots whereby it becomes effective.

HOW TO APPLY: Preferably by mechanical applicator, such as a fertilizer spreader, adjusted to deliver at a pre-determined rate. where use of a spreader is not feasible, weighed amounts may be scattered by hand over measured areas. In either case, uniform distribution is essential to uniform results. If weed growth or ground litter is such as to interfere with even distribution on the soil, cut and remove such material before applying BORASCU. MAINTENANCE: If necessary, make spot applications where weeds re-appear, or general retreatment using from one-half to full amount of initial rate of application. Such subsequent treatments tend to build up an area of unproductive soil, thereby minimizing reinfestations.
