**USE FOR CONTROLLING VEGETATION ON
RAILROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY**

HIBOR weed and grass killer should be applied without further dilution. Apply at the rate of 100 to 200 gallons per acre (Approximately 1/4 to 1/2 gallon per 100 sq. feet) using a pressure sprayer. For control of perennial grasses and perennial broad leaved weeds, the heavier rates are suggested. For control of annual weeds, apply HIBOR as a contact spray when plants are young, thoroughly wetting all parts of the plant, particularly the growing tips. For control of perennial grasses, such as Johnson grass, late summer or fall applications are recommended.

Do not apply HIBOR sprays on desirable plants or over the root area of desirable trees or shrubs. Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants.
