Borax WP is a water soluble inorganic borate salt for the protection and treatment of wood, wood products and wood-foam composite structural components against decay fungi and wood boring beetles including Powder Post Beetles (Lyctidae), Furniture Beetles and Old House Borers (Anobiidae), and Longhorn Beetles (Cerambycidae). This treatment is not effective against wood staining fungi and may require mixing with compatible registered anti-sapstain products. Borax WP also controls Subterranean Termites (Reticulitermes, Coptotermes, Heterotermes), Dampwood Termites (Zootermopsis), Drywood Termites (Kalotermes, Incisitermes), and Carpenter Ants (Camponotus).

Borax WP is recommended for all interior and exterior wood and wood-foam composite structural components which when utilized will be protected from rain and not in rect contact with the ground. The treatment of lumber is permanent even after cutting and finishing providing the wood is not exposed to water for a prolonged period of time or in contact with the ground.

This product is toxic to wood destroying insects but surface etching of treated wood and wood-foam composite structural components may occur.

Pressure process

Pressure treatment procedures must rigidly adhere to the standards of U.S. Borax and/or those of the American Wood Preservers Association. Borax WP is to be applied by vacuum pressure processes to achieve a target retention of 0.17 lb cuft B2O3 loading in the wood. Depending on wood species and moisture content, a Borax WP solution concentration of 1 to 6% W/W in water should be used to achieve this. If several species are being treated at once, choose the treating schedule for the most difficult to treat species. ACCEPTED
