

Mint 7.5 II has been formulated to aid in the reduction of cross-contamination in institutions, schools, and hospitals.

Mint 7.5 II is a one-step disinfectant-cleaner that is effective against a broad spectrum of bacteria, is virucidal, fungicidal, and will prevent the growth of mold and mildew and their odors when used as directed. Mint 7.5 II is an effective one-step sanitizer-cleaner for use on non-food contact surfaces.

When used as directed, Mint 7.5 II will deodorize surfaces in toilet areas, behind and under sinks and counters, garbage cans and garbage storage areas, and other places where bacterial growth can cause malodors.

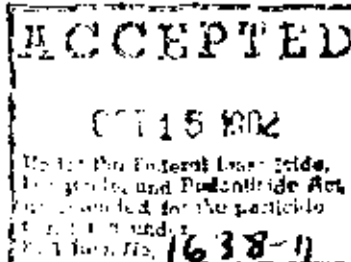

ADAC Fungicidal Test
Mint 7.5 II at 1 oz. per gallon is an effective fungicide (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on floors, shower and bath areas, especially for mold and mildew control.

At 1 oz. per gallon, Mint 7.5 II is effective in killing mold when applied to hard, non-porous surfaces (see above). Allow to dry on surface and repeat application.

Virucidal Performance
At 1 oz. per gallon use level, Mint 7.5 II is effective against influenza A/Brazil/68/119 for 1 minute, non-enveloped lipophilic and for 1 minute, non-enveloped hydrophilic and for 1 minute, non-enveloped hydrophilic and for 1 minute, non-enveloped hydrophilic. It is effective against Staph. aureus, E. coli, and S. marcescens. The same ADAC tests for hospitals were used.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to sell this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mint 7.5 II is a protein-formulated cleaner and sanitizer for use on hard non-porous surfaces in the presence of moderate concentrations of organic salt.

Apply Mint 7.5 II to walls, floors and other hard non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks and bathtubs with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device. Allow to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection — To disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces in hospitals, add 2 oz. per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. At this strength Mint 7.5 II is also virucidal, fungicidal and mildewstat. At 1 oz. per gallon Mint 7.5 II will disinfect hard non-porous surfaces in schools, industry and non-medical institutions.

Sanitizing — To sanitize porous or non-porous non-food contact surfaces, add 1/4 oz. per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 60 seconds.

For hospitals and nursing homes, add 1/2 oz. per gallon of water.

The broad spectrum of Mint 7.5 II has been evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and found to be effective against the following organisms by the AOAC five dilution test.

AOAC Fungicidal Test

Mint 7.5 II at 1 oz. per gallon is an effective fungicide against *Trichophyton mentagrophytes* (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on surfaces in areas such as locker rooms, dressing rooms, shower and bath areas, exercise facilities, etc.

Mold and Mildew Control

At 1 oz./gallon, Mint 7.5 II will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odors caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous surfaces (as indicated in general instructions above). Allow to dry on surface and repeat when mold or mildew growth returns.

Virucidal Performance

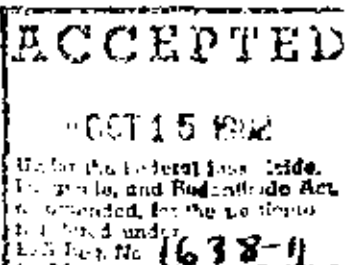
At 1 oz. per gallon use level, Mint 7.5 II was evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and found to be effective against Influenza A/Brazil Virus on non-metallic environmental surfaces.

For schools, non-medical institutions and laboratory use.

At 1 oz. per gallon of water, Mint 7.5 II delivers excellent cleaning and germicidal effectiveness. It is effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis* and *Escherichia coli*. The same AOAC tests used above to confirm suitable performance for hospitals were used.

Sanitizing-Non-Food Contact Surfaces (such as floors, walls, tables, etc.)

At 1/4 oz. (gallon use level), Mint 7.5 II is an effective sanitizer against *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Klebsiella pneumoniae* in the presence of 5% serum on porous and non-porous surfaces. (See label for details.)
