KNOX GENERAL WEED KILLER kills most vegetation with one spray application; when sprayed on the noxious weeds at the rate of one gallon per 200 square feet.

APPLICATION

As KNOX GENERAL WEED KILLER is a powerful contact herbicide, it will kill all foliage with which it comes in contact; however, only that foliage which is actually contacted will be affected. This means that it must not be sprayed onto desirable plants and must be used so as to thoroughly wet unwanted plants.

Apply KNOX GENERAL WEED KILLER by sprinkling can, hand-pump compression shoulder-strap sprayer, or power high-pressure sprayer. This solution must not be diluted—it can be sprayed effectively rain or shine. When KNOX GENERAL WEED KILLER is sprayed on a weed, it defoliates the entire plant and chokes the root in a single application.

For killing weeds along a railroad right-of-way, use 130 gallons of KNOX GENERAL WEED KILLER to the mile of track.

CAUTION

DO NOT USE NEAR OPEN FLAME. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED OR ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN. Causes skin irritation, wash thoroughly after handling. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Avoid contact with skin, inhalation of vapors and the contamination of foodstuffs and food containers. In case of swallowing, give an emetic to induce vomiting, such as a tablespoon of mustard in a glass of warm water. Follow with an antidote such as milk or raw egg. Call a physician.
