STOKELY-VAN CAMP FORMULA No. 999

A concentrated residual insecticide to be diluted on the basis of one gallon of Formula No. 999 with nine gallons of water. It is best to add the water to the concentrate rather than adding the concentrate to the water.

To be used as a regular residual insecticide on docks, shipping platforms, screens, and in any of the sections where edible foods are not present.

Kills flies, mosquitoes, roaches, ants, spiders and certain other insects. Repeat spraying at regular intervals or as needed. Application should be made so that the insecticide reaches all cracks and crevices and other hiding places.

Do not spray in any areas where the affected insect may fall into food, food containers or food processing equipment.

This product is a multi-mixture of Malathion, Lindane and Methoxychlor.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: 88.80%

- Xylene
- *Malathion
- **Methoxychlor, Technical
- Methylated Naphthalenes
- Gamma isomer of benzene hexachloride from Lindane

INERT INGREDIENTS: 11.20%

- *0,0-dimethyl dithiophosphate of diethyl mercaptosuccinate
- **Equivalent to 8.8% 2,2-bis(p-methoxyphenyl)-1,1,1-Tri-chloroethane and 1.2% other isomers and related compounds.

CAUTION

Do not use near open flame. Do not use in milk rooms or food processing rooms. Remove animals and poultry from buildings before treating. Do not use in dwellings. Do not treat plants or animals. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing, avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contamination of foodstuffs and food containers. Wash thoroughly after handling. Keep out of reach of children. Harmful to fish and aquatic life. If you or a pet, or a property, get prompt medical aid. Atropine is the antidote.

ANTIDOTE

EXTERNAL - Wash with soap and water. INTERNAL - Drink emetic of mustard oil preparation.
