**FORMULA No. 999 - SPECIAL**

A concentrated residual insecticide to be diluted on the basis of one gallon of Formula No. 999 Special with nine gallons of water. It is best to add the water to the concentrate rather than adding the concentrate to the water.

To be used as a regular residual insecticide on docks, shipping platforms, screens, and in any of the sections where edible foods are not present.

Kills flies, mosquitoes, roaches, ants, spiders and certain other insects. Repeat spraying at regular intervals or as needed. Application should be made so that the insecticide reaches all cracks and crevices and other hiding places.

This product is a multi-mixture of Diazinon, Lindane and Methoxychlor.

\*Methoxychlor, Technical  
Equivalent to 8.8% 2,2-bis(p-methoxyphenyl)-1,1,1-trichloroethane and 1.2% other isomers and related compounds  
\*\*Otherwise known as Diazinon.

**CAUTION**
