Panel 1.

General Deodorant Directions:

Dissolve one rounded measure (approximately 3 gablespoons) in two gallons of water to deodorize and sanitize - Garbage cans - Pet cages - Shower floors and walls - Kennels - Drains - Sumps, etc.

CAUTION - Harmful if taken internally. In the event of skin contact rinse with clear water. Keep out of the reach of children.

Panel 2. (Front Face)

Directions for chemical toilets

For good odor control in mobile home toilets place one rounded measure (approximately three tablespoons) in toilet before starting use. Add one additional rounded measure for each three gallons accumulation in holding tank.

In standard non-flush 5 gallon capacity toilets dissolve one rounded measure in 1 gallon of water and place in toilet. Empty toilet when about 1/2 to 2/3 full. Dispose of holding tank contents or 5 gallon toilet contents at regular intervals through burial or by dumping into sewage disposal systems other than bacterial type septic tanks.
