ALSO ESPECIALLY SUITED FOR SURFACES SUCH AS Flooring, Walls, Ceilings, Woodwork, Doors and Furniture DIRECTIONS: Diluted solutions can be applied in any convenient manner such as scrubbing, mopping, flooding, or wiping. In cases where excessive amounts of soil and contamination are present, clean before disinfecting for maximum effectiveness. The surface should be thoroughly wetted with the disinfecting solution and allowed to dry without rinsing.

For General Cleaning And Disinfecting: use 2 ounces of Clean-O-Lite per gallon of water.

¹For Control Of Pseudomonas And For Cleaning And Disinfecting In Hospitals: use 4 ounces of Clean-O-Lite per gallon of water.

For Cleaning And Sanitizing Food Processing Equipment And Utensils: avoid contact with foods and packaging materials. Use 2 ounces of Clean-O-Lite per gallon of water.
