SANITIZATION OF NONPOROUS NON-FOOD CONTACT SURFACES

RINSE METHOD - Prepare a sanitizing solution by adding 1/2 cup of BLEACH to 1 gallon of water. Immerse the surface to be sanitized in the solution for 2 minutes. Before use, rinse the surface thoroughly with the sanitizing solution. Rinse the surface with the sanitizer. Do not use surfaces with water after treatment and do not use the surface overnight.

IMMERSION METHOD - Prepare a sanitizing solution by adding 1/2 cup of BLEACH to 1 gallon of water. Immerse the surface to be sanitized in the solution for 2 minutes. Before use, rinse the surface thoroughly with the sanitizing solution. Rinse the surface with the sanitizer. Do not use surfaces with water after treatment and do not use the surface overnight.
