FOR OUTDOOR USE:

- Place all six stakes around the outside of the home as follows:
1. Place one stake in the ground on each side of all outside doors, or
 2. Place one stake near each corner of the house.
 3. Space remainder of stakes around the house at six-foot intervals. For larger homes, apartment houses or other buildings, additional ant stakes will be required. Ant stakes must not be placed farther than six feet apart.
 4. Pour a cupful of warm water over each stake. Stir the contents of each stake with a nail or matchstick. Repeat this procedure when ants are unusually active.

FOR ORNAMENTAL GARDEN USE:

- Grant's Ant Control helps promote better flower, shrub and tree culture, as ants carry Aphis and Scale. Grant's Ant Control, if used according to directions, help control this problem.
- In flower beds or rows, place stakes not more than six feet apart where ants are most active.
 - To protect trees and shrubs place one or more stakes at the base of each.
 - Follow step 4 given above and also sprinkle stakes occasionally when watering to improve effectiveness.
