Grant's Ant Control is poisonous if taken internally. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Keep away from children, pets, and incompetent persons. If swallowed, CALL A PHYSICIAN. This product is toxic to birds and other wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water by disposal of wastes, and apply this product only as specified on this label.

Give a tablespoon of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Then give two tablespoons of Epsom Salts or Milk of Magnesia in water and plenty of milk and water. Have patient lie down and keep quiet. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

FOR OUTDOOR USE:

1. Place six stakes around the outside of the home as follows:
a. Place one stake in the ground on each side of all outside doors, or
2. Place one stake near each corner of the house.
3. Space remainder of stakes around the house at six-foot intervals. For larger homes, apartment houses or other buildings, additional ant stakes will be required. Ant stakes must not be placed farther than six feet apart.
4. Pour a cupful of warm water over each stake. Stir the contents of each stake with a nail or matchstick. Repeat this procedure when ants are unusually active.

FOR ORNAMENTAL GARDEN USE:

- Grant's Ant Control helps promote better flower, shrub and tree culture, as ants carry Aphids and Scales. Grant's Ant Control, if used according to directions, help control this problem.
- In flower beds or rows, place stakes not more than six feet apart where ants are most active.
 - To protect trees and shrubs place one or more stakes at the base of each.
 - Follow step 4, given above and also sprinkle stakes occasionally when watering to improve effectiveness.
