DIRECTIONS

Read entire label carefully before using. Use only in accordance with label cautions, warnings and directions.

Shake before Use. Hold container in Upright Position to Point Valve Opening away from face when spraying. Apply in Bursts.

INDOOR

To Kill **ROACHES AND WATER BUGS**: Spray baseboards, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes, cabinets, etc., where roaches hide. Hit as many insects as possible with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill **ANTS**: Spray ant hills liberally. Spray ant trails over windows and door sills and other locations. Repeat as needed.

To Kill **FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND FLYING MOTHS**: Close doors and windows. Cover with heavy paper or cloth, or remove exposed food and utensils. Direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 second average room. Keep nozzle 3 feet from surface. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Remove persons and pets prior to and ventilate room prior to re-entry.

Do not make application when food is present or unprotected. Handling utensils and equipment should be protected or rinsed with potable water after exposure to mist. Repeat as needed.

For **HOUSE PLANTS**: Spray in short bursts, holding the can 18 inches from foliage for English Ivy and African Violets. Spray both sides of the leaves lightly. Do Not Wet. Repeat as often as necessary. Kills Aphids, Spider Mites, Thrips (Exposed), Lace Bugs.

OUTDOOR

For insects on **Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Gladioli, Irises, Marigolds, Petunias, Roses and Snapdragons**. Also, for insects specified below on **Evergreens and Ornamental Deciduous Trees, Shrubs and Vines**.

When sprayed directly on insects this spray will Kill sucking insects: **APHIDS, LEAFHOPPERS, SPOTTED MITES, THRIPS** (exposed) and **LACEBUGS**. Kills chewing insects: **ARMYWORM LARVAE, CAN BEAN BEETLE, CLIMBING CUTWORMS** and **JAPANESE BEE** when sprayed directly.

For best results spray in evening or on a cloudy day when plants are still. Use slow sweeping motion. Keep the can 18 inches from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of one foot per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat as needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth not sprayed when temperatures exceed 90° F. For Use on Patios, and in the Yard and Picnic Area to Kill **FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS**, and other Small Flying Insects. Fog the area liberally. Spray with the breeze allowing the fog to drift into shrubbery and places where insects harbour. Repeat as necessary.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. Wash skin and hands thoroughly after using. Do not spray around birds or fish. Do not contaminate food or feed with utensils, dishes or drinking water.

WARNING: Flammable! Contents under pressure. Do not use near sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F. may cause bursting. May stain finished surface if sprayed too closely. Do not spray on plastic, asphalt or varnished wood.
