**CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin. Use gloves if applying by hands. Wash with soap and water after use. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuff.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place away from heat and open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap container and dispose of in trash collection.

To prevent your pet, or stray animals, from soiling flower beds, areas of lawn, trees, shrubbery or evergreens: Apply these granules by hand or with a fertilizer spreader to borders of flower beds; or to ground and grass around the base of shrubs, trees and evergreens; or to patches of lawn you wish to protect. Sprinkle enough to cover the treated area lightly (about 4 pounds per 1000 sq. ft., or 1-2 cupfuls for 100 sq. ft.). Repeat applications until the undesirable animal habits are broken. Repeat applications after rains.

To protect garbage cans and rubbish containers from disturbance by dogs and cats, sprinkle the ground or floor about them liberally with granules. Repeat as necessary.

Stray animals are frequently attracted to areas where urine or feces have been deposited. First, remove any droppings, then apply these granules.

Do not apply these granules directly to foliage of shrubs or to ornamental, soft-bodied plants. Do not apply on or near food crops.

GENERAL: The most effective control for a pet is the sharply spoken word backed up with disciplinary action. For most effective results on pets, this repellent product should be used in conjunction with training.
