Review of label

The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product. A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

1. Revise your homeowner "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" text as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store only in the original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal:

- Empty containers: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available.
- Partly filled containers: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Do not place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
- 2. At the top of your "Back/side" panel, change "10 days" to "24 hours" to be consistent with other label text, "Will repel dogs and cats up to 24 hours when applied daily."
- 3. Because this is an outdoor product, in your "USE RESTRICTIONS", delete "For both indoor and outdoor situations" and "furniture, carpet".
