IN THE HOUSE

DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT, STAIN REMOVER, Refrigerator: Add 1/2 tsp. A-1 Bleach to 1 quart of water. Wash refrigerator shelves. Keep wet with bleach for 5 minutes. Rinse, dry, and use.

Sinks, Basins, Tubs, Showers: Drain with hot water. Follow by 1/2 cup of A-1 Bleach.

Toilet Bowls: Pour 1/2 cup A-1 Bleach to bowl. Brush solution over all inside surfaces. Let stand an hour or longer. Flush.

Garbage Cans: Mix 1/2 cup A-1 Bleach to quart of water. Wash with hot suds, soak 5 minutes in bleach, rinse, dry.

Sickroom: Urinals, Bed Pans, Rubber sheets: Add 1/2 tsp. A-1 Bleach to quart of water. Wash thoroughly, immerse in bleach 5 minutes, rinse, dry.

HEALTH DEPARTMENT requirements for sanitizing thoroughly cleaned surfaces and utensils in TAVERNS, RESTAURANTS, FOUNTAINS AND DAIRIES: Add 1 ounce A-1 Bleach to 1 gallon water. Prepare a disinfecting solution 200 parts per million available chlorine. Immerse all utensils for at least 5 minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code. Air dry.

TO BLEACH AND DISINFECT Drainboards, shelves: Add 1/2 tsp. of A-1 Bleach to quart of water. Wash thoroughly, apply bleach solution, let stand 15 minutes, rinse, dry.

Floors: Mix 1 cup of A-1 Bleach to 1/2 gallon water. Rub with brush, wash thoroughly, apply bleach solution, let stand 5 or 10 minutes, rinse, dry.

AS A GERMICIDE Emergency Drinking water: Add 10 drops A-1 Bleach to 1 gallon of water. Let stand 15 minutes. Use as a protective against bacteria contamination.

KEEP BOTTLE IN A COOL PLACE, TIGHTLY CAPPED IN AN UPRIGHT POSITION. USE A-1 BLEACH ON WHITE AND FAST COLORS ONLY. DO NOT USE ON SILK, WOOL, LEATHER OR SPONGE.

FABRICS

USE A-1 BLEACH ON ALL THESE FABRICS
(white and colorfast)

- Cotton
- Linen
- Rayon (Avril)
- Acrylic (Orlon, Acrilan)
- Acetate
- Nylon
- Modacrylic (Dyneel)
- Polyester (Dacron, Kodan, Fortrel)
- Triacetate

and blends of these fibers. **PERMANENT PRESS** fabrics, both white and colorfast, can be safely bleached. **DO NOT USE** on silk, wool, mohair, leather, spandex (Spira), non-fast colors. Dilute A-1 Bleach before using on any fabric.

IN THE LAUNDRY

LAUNDERING: In soaking Suds: Add 1 tbsp. A-1 Bleach to 1 gallon of water, add soap or detergent. Immerse 15 minutes to overnight. Wash, then rinse.

In Washing Suds: Immerse laundry, wash, rinse.

Automatic Washers: Mix 1 tbsp. A-1 Bleach with 1 gallon water. Immerse laundry, add soap or detergent, dilute Bleach in quart of water before adding.

In first rinse after washing: Add 1 tbsp. A-1 Bleach to 1 gallon water, add laundry, soak 15 minutes, rinse thoroughly.

REMOVING STAINS, SCORCH or MILDEW: Soak stained material in cold water 10 minutes. Add 1 quart water mixed with 2 tbsp. A-1 Bleach. Soak in bleach 15 minutes. Repeat if necessary. Dry in sun if possible.

CAUTION / DO NOT USE BLEACH WITH AMMONIA OR TOILET BOWL CLEANERS.

MAY CAUSE SEVERE SKIN AND EYE IRRITATION. IN CASE OF CONTACT WITH SKIN AND EYES FLUSH WITH PLENTY OF WATER. IF TAKEN INTERNALLY DRINK MILK, WHITE OF EGG OR FEED COOKED CEREAL. CALL A PHYSICIAN. AVOID TRANSFER TO FOOD OR BEVERAGE CONTAINERS. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. MAY BE HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.
