- 2. Revise the Precautionary Statements by changing the phrase "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling." to read "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."
- 3. Revise the Environmental Hazards section language to read "This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms."
- 4. Revise the Storage and Disposal section as follows:
 - a. Add the phrases "In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water. Product or rinsates that cannot be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer." as the last statements in the Storage section.

b. Revise the statement "Offer for recycling, if available." to read "Offer for recycling, if available or placehouterates llection."
