

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. FOR LIGHT DUTY CLEANING AND SHINING, use 1/3 ounce MIKRO-QUAT per gallon of water or hot water.
2. FOR COMPARISON DISINFECTION AND CLEANING use 2/3 ounce per gallon of water (provides 470 ppm active quaternary germicide). For porous or heavily soiled surface, use 1 ounce per gallon of water (780 ppm).
3. KILLS PSEUDOMONAS PUM (T. Interdigitale) on inanimate hard surfaces at the recommended use concentration of 2/3 oz. per gallon (1:200).
KILLS BILLOM PUM on inanimate hard surfaces at the recommended use concentration of 2/3 oz. per gallon (1:200).
4. FOR BATHS AND SWIMMING POOL SANITATION:
 - a. Scrub and prebrush to remove excess soil.
 - b. Wash in solution of 1/3 oz. MIKRO-QUAT per gallon of water or other recommended detergent.
 - c. Rinse with clean water.
 - d. Sanitize by:
Immersing objects in 2 minutes in a solution of 1/3 ounce MIKRO-QUAT per gallon of water.
 - e. Rinse with potable water and air dry.

PRECAUTIONS
