

# SURSAN

SURSAN contains a modern disinfectant to give an economical extra purpose cleaner with the added feature of bacterial destruction. Specifically designed for use in schools and institutions housing large numbers of people. If used on floors and walls according to label directions it will markedly decrease the concentration of pathogenic microorganisms, usually found on these surfaces. It also has an excellent built-in deodorizing property in which odors actually combine chemically with SURSAN, rather than a masked odor as is so often the case with deodorizers.

SURSAN provides unusually fast soil penetration powerful dispersing action, non-rinse cleaning completely free from spotting and streaking, leaving a fragrant disinfected area.

Use dilution tests show it to be effective as a disinfectant when used at two ounces per gallon against Staphylococcus aureus - - Salmonella typhosa.

### WARNING: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

#### DIRECTIONS

FLOORS - Use at two ounces per gallon of water by scrubbing with a wet mop, wipe up. Do not rinse with clean water; allow to dry as is to benefit from clean water; allow to dry as is to benefit from residual bacteriostatic activity.

WALLS, WOODWORK, CEILINGS - Especially effective for washing walls, woodwork and ceilings.

Should be used at two ounces per gallon of water. By scrubbing, excess solution should be removed by damp wiping with a clean cloth or sponge. Will not damage surfaces when used according to directions.

FURNITURE, EQUIPMENT - Use at two ounces per gallon of water, scrubbing and then wiping damp dry.

MECHANICAL SCRUBBERS - Use at two ounces per gallon according to equipment manufacturer's direction.

SPECIAL CLEANING PROBLEMS - Generally use at two ounces per gallon. If use solutions contain less than two ounces of SURSAN per gallon of water, the solution must be considered as a cleaning solution only and not as a disinfectant. If in doubt, ask your Lystadman.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
