Residual Bacteriostatic and Residual Self-Sanitizing Activity under conditions of high relative humidity or wet contamination.

Fabric treated with TEX STAT as directed below will develop residual bacteriostatic and residual self-sanitizing activity against Gram Positive (*Staphylococcus aureus*) and Gram Negative (*Klebsiella pneumoniae*) organisms.

Fabric treated with TEX STAT which has become contaminated or soiled through use will inhibit the growth of many organisms not only at the time of exposure, but also through the handling and transportation procedures until the garments are again laundered and treated with TEX STAT.

It is particularly effective in inhibiting the growth of ammonia-producing organisms such as *Brevibacterium ammonigenes* which acts on urine in the diaper to produce ammonia.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TEX STAT is recommended for use in the final rinse cycle of the laundry operation. Introduce TEX STAT into the wash water at the rate of 1/4 ounce of TEX STAT per 100 pounds of dry laundry. It is recommended that TEX STAT be added halfway through the final rinse cycle during operation.
