DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
For Dairy and Food Processing Equipment, Tanks, Tank Trucks, Silos, Vats, Pails, Pipelines and Closed Systems: Prior to use of this product, remove gross food particles and soil by a pre-flush, or pre-scrape and, when necessary, presoak treatment from all surfaces. Then wash with detergent or other cleaning solution followed by a thorough potable water rinse. Sanitize using a solution of 1 fluid ounce Pennsan NR in 5 gallons of water. All surfaces should be exposed to the sanitizing solution for a period of not less than 2 minutes. Drain thoroughly.
Beverage Plants
 Pre-mix and post-mix vending machines, plant equipment: Sanitize pre-cleaned surfaces with PENNSAN NR (1 ounce/5 gallons of water). Drain sanitizing solutions from the system.

NOTE: FOR MECHANICAL OPERATIONS prepared use solution may not be reused for sanitizing but may be reused for other purposes such as cleaning. FOR MANUAL OPERATIONS fresh sanitizing solution should be prepared as soon as they become diluted or soiled.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS-HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage or skin burns. Harmful if swallowed or adsorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear goggles or face shield. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush immediately with plenty of water while holding eyelids apart. Remove any contact lenses and continue flushing for 15 minutes. Call a poison control center or physician immediately.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing. Flush with plenty of water and wash affected area with mild soap and water. If symptoms persist, call a poison control center or physician.

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately rinse mouth out with water and give sips of water.
