HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage or skin burns. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

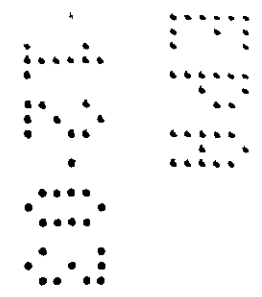
Have the product container or label with you when calling a Poison Control Center or doctor or going for treatment.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Dairy and Food Processing Equipment, Tanks, Tank Trucks, Silos, Vats, Pails, Pipelines and Closed Systems: Prior to use of this product, remove gross food particles and soil by pre-flush, or pre-scrape and, when necessary, presoak treatment from all surfaces. Then wash with detergent or other cleaning solution followed by a thorough potable water rinse. Sanitize using a solution of 1 fluid ounce *Pennsan NR* in 5 gallons of water. All surfaces should be exposed to the sanitizing solution for a period of not less than 2 minutes. Drain thoroughly.

BEVERAGE PLANTS

Pre-mix and post-mix vending machines, plant equipment: Sanitize pre-cleaned surfaces with *Pennsan NR* (1 ounce/5 gallons of water). Drain sanitizing solutions from the system.

NOTE: FOR MECHANICAL OPERATIONS prepared use solutions may not be reused for sanitizing but may be reused for other purposes such as cleaning.

FOR MANUAL OPERATIONS fresh sanitizing solution should be prepared as soon as they become diluted or soiled.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store container upright in cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. Store product in original container, away from other pesticides, fertilizers, food and feed. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Keep from freezing.
