**Conditions**

1. Revise "If Swallowed" section to read:

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**IF INHALED:** Move the person to fresh air. If the person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

SOLID CHOICE PLUS contains a bacteriostatic multiple phenolic system which is designed to keep conveying systems clean and free of slime and odor producing microorganisms.

**DIRECTION FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For best results spray or foam clean conveyors with an Ecolab recommended detergent to remove soil and slime buildups. For bacteriostatic conveyor lubrication spray-apply a 0.20% by weight (1.0 ounce to 3.75 gallons of water, 1:500) dilution of SOLID CHOICE PLUS in water through an ECOLAB Inc. solid lubricant dispenser. For heavy duty lubrication/cleaning needs spray-apply up to a 0.75% by weight (1.0 ounce to 1.0 gallon of water, 1:133) dilution of SOLID CHOICE PLUS in water. No need to rinse with potable water or remove product as SOLID CHOICE PLUS can be continuously applied to conveyors to prevent slim and soil buildups during production runs.

**DIRECTIONS FOR DISPENSER LOADING:**

Remove container lid. Invert container over solid lubricant dispenser. Puncture bottom of container with air point tool, checking to be sure the container lid has been removed. Use air point tool to push SOLID CHOICE PLUS into the solid lubricant dispenser.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Do not store above 120 deg. F..
