- 6. Your Confidential Statement of Formula dated May 7, 1997, for the Basic Formulation is acceptable and supersedes all previously submitted CFSs for the Basic Formulation. This information has been placed in the file for the subject product.
- 7. Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
