DairyGlide AM provides exceptional lubricity and superior cleaning ability at low use dilutions. *DairyGlide AM* keeps conveyors free of slime and soil buildups. For best results, clean conveyors with a suitable detergent to remove soil and slime buildup. Apply through standard conveyor lubricant spray nozzles using a conveyor lubricant dispensing system such as the Mikro Master® 300. *DairyGlide AM* must be used in soft water.

FOR CONTINUOUS TREATMENT OF NON-FOOD CONTACT DAIRY PROCESSING CONVEYORS

For tabletop conveyors, apply 0.25% v/v (2500 ppm or 0.32 oz/gal) – 0.50% v/v (5000 ppm or 0.64 oz/gal) solution of *DairyGlide AM*. For in-floor conveyors, apply 0.35% v/v (3500 ppm or 0.45 oz/gal) – 0.80% v/v (8000 ppm or 1.02 oz/gal) solution of *DairyGlide AM*.

FOR CONTINUOUS TREATMENT OF NON-FOOD CONTACT BEVERAGE AND BREWERY PROCESSING CONVEYORS

For metal or plastic conveyors, apply 0.15% v/v (1500 ppm or 0.19 oz/gal) – 0.35% v/v (3500 ppm or 0.45 oz/gal) solution of *DairyGlide AM*. For can transfers, apply 0.25% v/v (2500 ppm or 0.32 oz/gal) – 0.60% v/v (6000 ppm or 0.77 oz/gal) solution of *DairyGlide AM*.
