PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Premier Klercide 70/30 IPA is designed for use in the pharmaceutical industry. It is effective as a general disinfectant on hard inanimate environmental surfaces (eg stainless steel, glass, corian, laminate flooring, aluminum, pvc, mild steel, polypropylene), in isolators, cleanrooms, sterile areas and on tools and equipment prior to their introduction into these areas. Effective against vegetative bacteria such as pseudomonas aeruginosa, staphylococcus aureus, salmonella enterica and fungi such as trichophyton mentagrophytes.

To disinfect hard surfaces and equipment. **Do not dilute.** Surfaces should be free from organic soiling prior to disinfection. Hold the container upright and spray the pre-cleaned surface from a distance of 6 to 8 inches, ensure an even coverage. Allow the surface to remain wet for at least 10 minutes.

Packed in a sealed sterile trigger spray container ready for use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STATEMENTS

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in the original container in a dry cool place below 120° F.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
