1. Revise the statement "Seedlings and other plant materials treated with this product must bear distinct labeling" to read "Seedlings and other plant materials treated with this product must bear distinct labeling that instructs:"
2. Separate the Environmental Hazards Section, to distinguish it from the Hazard to Human Domestic Animals Section.
3. Move the Storage and Disposal section so that it follows the Violation statement.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

When using Hormo-Root powder it is desirable to have bottom heat preferably between 70-75° F. Treated cuttings should not have less than a 60° F temperature. Any rooting medium may be used but a mixture of sand and peat has been found very satisfactory for plant vegetative reproduction.

A scientifically balanced Hormone-like preparation embodying highly effective fungicidal qualities for the stimulation of strong, healthy roots, or control of rot.

For "No Root 'C'" using the powder dipping procedure as recommended for the treatment of Andromeda, Arbutus (scorodolifolia types), Beauty Bush, Bouvardia, Camellia, Ceanothus, Heather, Holly (American, English, and Chinese varieties), Plant, Rhododendrons (Yew (Japanese types).
