The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to update and revise the product labeling, is acceptable provided that you make the following revisions:

1. Specify the time expressed in terms of minutes needed to clean the toilet room, urinals, and water closets section.
2. Revise the statement, "leaving the emulsion in the bowl as long as possible" to read as follow: "leaving the emulsion $\underline{x}$ minutes in the bowl." A time limit expressed in minutes must be included in this subsection.
3. Delete the term. "stable", from the product labeling.
4. Delete the term, " of all kinds", from the product labeling. It is considered misleading and does not specify the type of building.
5. Delete the term, "high-grade". from the product labeling.
6. Under the "To Disinfect and Deodorize Garbage Cans" section, revise the statement "Leave dilution in the can" to read "Leave dilution in the can for ten minutes". A time limit expressed in minutes must be included in this subsection.
