DIRECTIONS:

Do not apply to any food, feed, or forage crops. It should be applied as a fog or fine mist to completely envelop the area to be treated in accordance with type of applicator employed and the manufacturer's recommendation.

ANTS — Thoroughly spray the ant hills and runways. Repeat the applications as reinfestation occurs.

MOSQUITOES AND GNATS — Envelop total area to be treated with a fine mist or a coarse fog. Pay particular attention to all zones of stagnation as ponds and low areas.

FLIES — Envelop in a fine fog or mist. Use fog in repelling flies for many critical areas as stables, barns, drive-ins, parks, and rubbish piles. **DO NOT USE IN DAIRY BARNS**, or on Dairy Animals or on **LIVESTOCK** intended for slaughter. Do not use on pets.

CAUTION Avoid fogging too close to dwellings, parked cars or other vehicles where oily residues would be undesirable. Repeated or prolonged contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid prolonged inhalation or skin contact. In case of spillage on skin, wash with soap and water immediately. Avoid contamination of feed and food stuffs. Harmful if swallowed.
